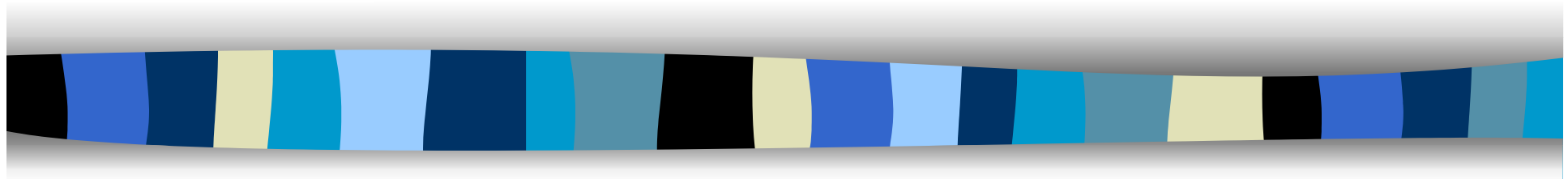

PROCUREMENT IN GENERAL

- **Decentralized to department level**
- **Must follow regulations issued by the Prime Minister Office**
- **Hardly any discussions among the purchasing officers in different departments**



ISSUES IN PROCUREMENT (1)

- **Procurement process is not suitable for the present age to cope with the electronic commodities**
- **Inability to develop neutral specifications for purchasing IT equipment leading to cancellation of purchasing process**



ISSUES IN PROCUREMENT (2)

- **Difficulty in evaluating IT consulting firms**
- **Difficulty in tracking companies who have previously ignored and deserted the awarded contracts**
- **Difficulty in judging and scoring the proposals**



e- PROCUREMENT IN THAILAND

- **New concepts**
- **Has been discussed in NITC and NECTEC**
- **Waiting for a clear policy from the Government**
- **Need to have a law to protect electronic contamination**
- **Need to have cooperation from all concerned**

- **IT and internet are necessary**
- **Databases must be developed for**
 - **Procurement Rules and Regulation**
 - **Standards**
 - **Specifications**
 - **Suppliers**

- **Modifications**



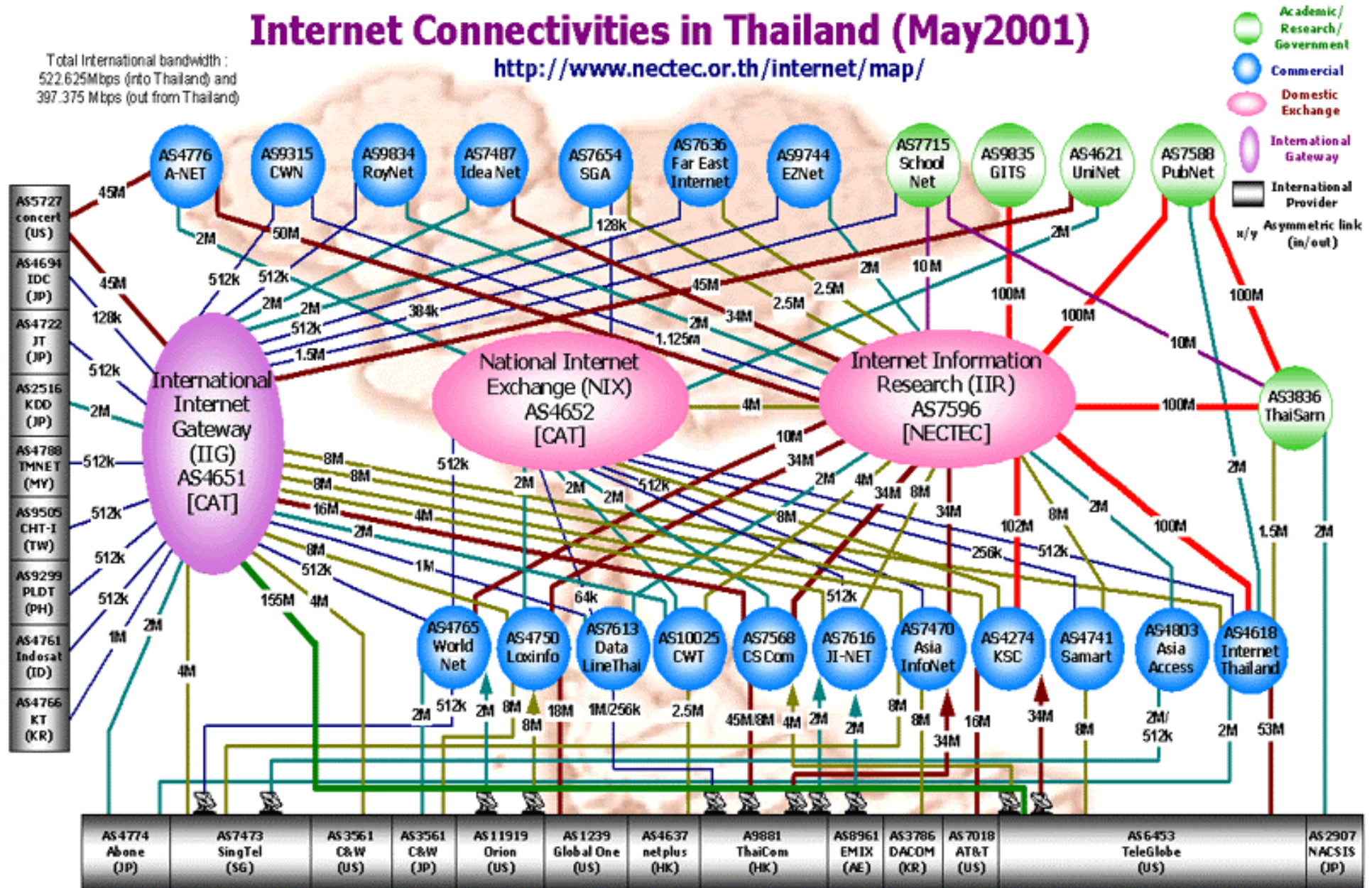
IT Infrastructure in Thailand
